

# Adobe JELA Fact Sheet



**Background:** On 30 SEP 13, the Defense Information Technology Contracting Organization (DITCO) Contracting Office in coordination with HQDA CIO/G-6 Enterprise Licensing Division and CHES, awarded a Joint Enterprise License Agreement (JELA) to CDW-G for Adobe licenses and software maintenance. This agreement covers the Army, Air Force and Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA). The Period of Performance for this agreement is 30 SEP 13 to 29 SEP 14 (Base Period), 30 SEP 14 to 29 SEP 15 (Option Year 1), and 30 SEP 15 to 29 SEP 16 (Option Year 2).

## What's included in the Adobe ELA?

Agreement includes Adobe Acrobat Professional and Adobe Experience Manager Document Services (AEM DS) PDF Creation Enterprise licenses, and Adobe Creative Cloud (CC), either full suite or single product term subscriptions.

The agreement allows for unlimited use of Adobe Acrobat Pro and AEM DS software, and use of each Adobe CC subscription on up to 5 devices. The cost of Enterprise Licenses and Base Year Maintenance are covered under this agreement, and a greatly reduced price for Adobe CC subscriptions. This agreement also includes migration to future software upgrades as soon the product obtains a Certificate of Networthiness (CoN).

### How is Cost Per License Calculated?

The cost of Enterprise Licenses and Base Year Maintenance was established upon contract award.

The cost of Option Year maintenance will be apportioned among Army organizations per product usage, and the cost of Adobe CC subscriptions will be paid by user Commands.
