

BMC ELA Fact Sheet

Background: On 24 SEP 13, the Defense Information Technology Contracting Organization (DITCO) Contracting Office, in coordination with HQDA CIO/G-6 Enterprise Licensing Division and CHES, modified an existing Army ELA with Four Points Technology, L.L.C for BMC licenses and software maintenance to extend the period of new license ordering for Option Year 4. The Period of Performance for this agreement is 30 SEP 10 to 28 FEB 11 (Base Period), 01 MAR 11 to 30 NOV 11 (Option Year 1), 01 DEC 11 to 31 OCT 12 (Option Year 2), 01 NOV 12 to 29 SEP 13 (Option Year 3), 30 SEP 13 to 29 SEP 14 (Option Year 4) and 30 SEP 14 to 29 SEP 15 (Option Year 5). Option Year 5 is maintenance only.

What's included in the BMC ELA ?

Software Products shall include all updates, upgrades, and new versions.

The Order will consist of a base period of 6 months, The first option period will consist of 8 months, the second and third options periods will be 11 months each, with the remaining option periods being one year each. Total base with five option periods equates to a five year order period.

Cost Per License

There is no immediate funding requirement for new licenses. However, there is a fee associated with the maintenance of the licenses.

How is Cost Per License Calculated?

The cost of Enterprise Licenses and Base Year Maintenance was established upon contract award. The cost of Option Year maintenance will be apportioned among Army organizations per product usage, and the cost of BMC subscriptions will be paid by user Commands.
