The Government shall order at least the quantity of supplies or services designated in the Schedule as the minimum.

(d) Any order issued during the effective period of this contract and not completed within that period shall be completed by the Contractor within the time specified in the order. The contract shall govern the Contractor's and Government's rights and obligations with respect to that order to the same extent as if the order were completed during the contract's effective period; provided, that the Contractor shall not be required to make/perform any deliveries/services under this contract after twelve (12) months from contract expiration.
