

**REQUEST FOR TRAINING
CISCO TECHNICAL EDUCATION**

As a value added service to the Cisco Enterprise Service Agreement (ESA), CIO/G-6 is able to offer training on Cisco platforms and technologies through the Cisco Technical Education (CTE) program. CTE is an e-learning portal that includes a variety of training modules on Cisco devices and software technologies. CTE is designed to provide network professionals with access to training on a variety of topics, such as routers, switches, data centers, and security technology -- all without leaving one's office.

CTE was developed specifically to meet the needs of those who want training, but either do not require or do not have the time for an in-depth, instructor-led training class. CTE gives the student access to the entire range of intermediate to advanced-level Technical Assistance Center (TAC) training resources used to educate Cisco's TAC Engineers. Cisco developed CTE as the "break-fix" training resource to teach just-in-time troubleshooting to network support professionals.

In order to obtain access to this training, please submit provide the information requested below. Approved users are entitled access to CTE content for one (1) year. At the end of this period, access can be renewed or transferred to a new user. Since there are a limited number of training accounts available, Army personnel (MIL, CIV, CTR) must attain their supervisor's approval to apply. NOTE: CTRs must have their Contract Officer Representative (COR) sign-off. This is to ensure that training is targeting personnel whose job duties require them to support Cisco technologies.
